1st Semester

1. Report for enrollment

7. Submit form for appointment of thesis advisor (Form GS1)*



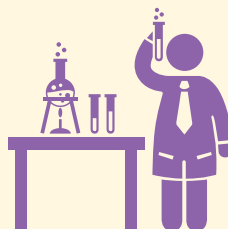
2nd Semester

3rd Semester

1. Register for the courses according to your study plan
2. Have the thesis committee appointed and pass the thesis/minor thesis proposal defense exam (Form GS2)* (The timing of the exam depends on the faculty)
3. Conduct your research project
4. Submit manuscript(s) based on your thesis work to journals and/or present at research conferences (Form GS 4/1)*



4th Semester

Master's Thesis

1. Register for the courses according to your study plan
2. Submit manuscript(s) based on your thesis work to journals and/or present at research conferences (Form GS 4/1)*
3. Request the appointment of the thesis examination committee and the thesis examination date (GS 3 & GS 4)*
4. Check your thesis for plagiarism via Turnitin (GS 14)*
5. Submit relevant pages for thesis format inspection by One Stop Service (GS 6)**
6. Submit a copy of the completed thesis together with the required documents (GS 8)*
7. Submit a request for completion of study online at <https://reg.psu.ac.th/isr/index.aspx>



Minor Thesis

1. Register for the courses according to your study plan
2. Pass the comprehensive exam (Plan B) (date and time are determined by the program)
3. Request the appointment of the minor thesis examination committee and the minor thesis examination date (set by the faculty)
4. Submit the completed minor thesis
5. Submit a request for completion of study online at <https://reg.psu.ac.th/isr/index.aspx>



Conditions for Graduation

1. Proof of english proficiency as required by the Graduate School***
2. All required courses have been completed with an overall GPA ≥ 3.00
3. Pass the thesis/minor thesis exam and submit the completed thesis/minor thesis
4. The research has been published according to the requirements of the regulations*/program/scholarship/others as a applicable
5. Other conditions****



Note: A maximum of two attempts are permitted for comprehensive exam and thesis exam respectively.

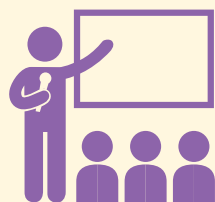
